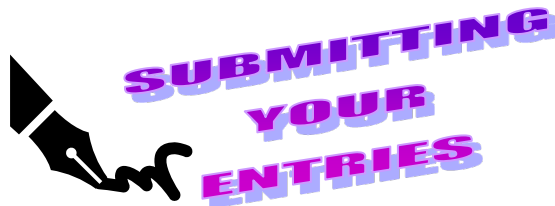

GENERAL RULES

All entries in the Creative Talent Division should follow these general rules.
Each contest division has its own set of rules and guidelines.

1. The Creative Talent Division of the Kaufman County Livestock Show is open to all residents of Kaufman County and those attending school in Kaufman County.
2. It is the responsibility of each contestant to read all rules set forth by the Creative Talent Superintendent. Failure to follow these rules will disqualify an individual's entry.
3. Entries in the Creative Talent Division must be appropriate for family viewing at the Fair.
4. Any entry that previously has been entered in KCJLS contest may not be re-entered.
5. All entries must be made by only the participant/group who is entering the contest.
6. Entries that contain edible components are prohibited except for DIVISION IV-FOODS.
7. Contestants must adhere to the age and skill divisions. If an entry is to be found in violation of the policy, it will be disqualified.
8. All entries must have a two-sided participant tag attached with all information filled out on both sides about the participant or group attached upon drop off. These will be provided to the participant upon drop off entry.
9. KCJLS does not provide easels, display stands, or mounting boards. It is the responsibility of the participant to supply.
10. It is distinctly understood that in no case will the Kaufman County Fair or Livestock Show, its director, or volunteers be held responsible for loss, damage, or injury to persons, vehicles, or articles while participating in the Kaufman County Fair.
11. All Divisions will be judged according to the following categories:
 - A. ADULT (19 + YRS OF AGE)-**NOT ELIGIBLE FOR AUCTION**
 - B. SENIOR (14-19 YRS OF AGE ATTENDING HIGH SCHOOL)
 - C. INTERMEDIATE (11-13 YRS OF AGE)
 - D. JUNIOR (8-10 YRS OF AGE)
 - E. CHILDREN (UNDER 7 YRS OF AGE)

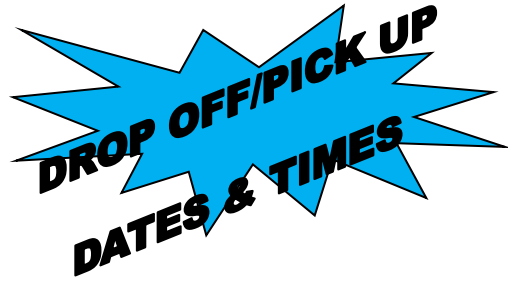

- An entry form must be completed to be entered into the Creative Talent Division. These forms can be photocopied.
- Entry forms must be received or posted marked **no later than Friday, February 7, 2025.**
- \$3.00 fee must be paid for each individual entry. Fee can be paid the day of drop off or by mail.
- Any entries forms received or posted marked after February 7, 2025, will be charged a late fee of \$2.00. **The total fee to enter after February 7, 2025 will be \$5.00 per entry.**
- Returned check fee of \$40.00 for any returned checks.

- All entries are judged on their individual merit.
- Blue, red, and white ribbons will be awarded based on the quality of the entry.
- Projects receiving a blue ribbon are not guaranteed a Class Champion placing.
- The judge's decision is final.
- Judges will not award ribbons to any unworthy exhibit, even if it is the only entry in the class.
- Four entries will be chosen from **ANY** of the Grand Champion or Reserve Division Champions in one of the following categories: Senior, Intermediate, Junior, and Children. Entries forms will be checked to see if the item is available for auction.
- All judges will determine the four auctions' items.
- The determination of the judge's selection for auction will NOT change the Overall Champion and Reserve Champion Placing.
- Only one (1) entry per student is eligible for auction (EXAMPLE: student can NOT auction a Creative Talent item and a Livestock Project).
- Any food item selected to be auctioned will be required to have a fresh-baked product (same entry) be made for the auction.
- All sales participants must have a backdrop photo taken by the official photographer.
- **IMPORTANT!!! Youth with an auction item will be required to help the day of auction with clean up and set up from 9:00 A.M. until finish. Parents are encouraged to attend and help in this preparation. Refusal or not assisting means you will be dropped from the sale order and an alternate moved up in the sale. A sign-in sheet must be signed when you arrive. NO EXCEPTIONS ALLOWED**
- A thank you letter must be written, with a copy turned into the County Extension Office before auction money can be received. 5% of the total sale amount will be kept by the Livestock Board to defray the cost of the show.

DIVISION I – FINE ARTS

- Entries will be judged on creativity, originality, quality of artistic composition, overall design, and overall impression of the art. What is the effect of the artwork in general and as a whole? Overall, does the artwork stand on its own as a complete and outstanding work of art?
- **NO FRAMES** will be allowed (The KCSB will not be held responsible for damages).
- **Mounting Boards will be required for all artworks.** All artworks must be mounted prior to drop off. **KCSB will not have mounting boards available at drop off.**
- **Create A Cover:** Senior Class (14-18 Yrs of age) has an opportunity to create next year rule book cover sheet (S1301 category code). Entries must be black and white. No color. Winning Entry will be kept by the superintendent until the following year rule book is able to be released. At that time the drawing will be returned to the artist.
- **Color a Cover:** Children Class (Under 7 Yrs of age) has an opportunity to color the front cover sheet to be entered.

DIVISION III - PHOTOGRAPHY

- This contest includes black & white and color photography featuring a variety of subjects.
- All photos must have been taken by the participant after January 1, 2024
- Each photo print must be an 8" x 10".
- Must be mounted on foam core or mat board showing a 1" border.
- **PROHIBITED ENTRIES: Entries will not be accepted if they are: • Metal printing. • Glass, frames, hangers, or brackets. • Entries with date, timestamp or name on the photo front. • Photos not on foam core or mat board. • Broken or damaged • No prior photo that have been entered in KCJLS**
- JUDGING: Criteria will include, but not limited to, the following:



Impact



Creativity



Technical



Composition



Subject Matter



Story Telling

- ALTERATIONS: Color photos AND black & white photos are allowed in all categories and will be judged together. Although slight computer alterations are allowed, such as cropping (but NO cut-out), minor adjustment of lighting, or brightness and red-eye reduction; No blurring or smudging; substantial alterations to photos such as applying design styles or using computer graphics are NOT allowed and will be disqualified.
- CATEGORY SUMMARY:
 - ❖ **Landscape & Nature (non-animal):** Focus of this category includes landscapes, outdoor scenic, nature images, sunsets, urban landscapes, sunsets, seascapes, cityscapes, and farms; images focus on the beauty of the outdoors. EX: gardens, landscapes, outdoors, scenic etc. NOT Allowed: primary subject is person, animal or single plant/flowers/flora.
 - ❖ **Plant/Flora:** Photos of interesting, unique, and beautiful flowers, and flora; photo may be outdoors or indoors; subject MUST be that of a single flower, plant bush, tree, etc. EX: a single rose, upward shot of a tree.

- ❖ **Architecture:** Focus is on the exterior or interior building, structures, bridges showing the architectural design of the subject or a portion of the subject. EX: cathedral, ornate bridge, capitol dome (inside or outside), cityscape with streets/highways/flyovers.
- ❖ **Food:** A still life specialization of photography aimed at producing attractive photographs of food for use in such items of advertisements, packaging, menus, and/or cookbooks. EX: cakes/pies, Easter eggs, fruits, place settings with food, ingredients, sandwiches, etc. NOT ALLOWED alcoholic beverages or their logos
- ❖ **Animals – Domestic:** Focus is on the various animals that have been domesticated and made fit for the human environment. Examples of domestic animals – cows, dogs, cats, hamsters, horses, pigs, sheep, goats, etc. NOT ALLOWED: birds, reptiles.
- ❖ **Animals – Wildlife:** Focus on animals not tamed or domesticated and commonly found in the wilderness or the bodies of water throughout the country and world. Photos can be of wildlife in nature, zoos, and or petting zoos. EX: reptiles, lizard, frogs, birds, deer, elephants, dolphins. NOT ALLOWED – photos taken through glass.
- ❖ **2025 This year's theme is "I AM KAUFMAN"**. Show your Kaufman County pride of with people, animals, items that represent Kaufman.
- ❖ **People:** Focus is from all walks of life, parenting/family, children, babies, models/fashion, sports, couples.
- ❖ **Motion/Action:** The capture of movement within a single photo. EX: horse running across field/pasture. Ferris Wheel Spinning, etc.
- ❖ **Catch All:** Category for photos that do not fit into one of the other categories. This includes such photos as still life, motion-blur, and people.
- ❖ **Media:** a visual story structured in the same way as a story. As a photographer fined an angle adding a human element that tells a story. EX. Photos of an event, weather, action shot, or interview

DIVISION IV - FOODS

- All items will be judged on appearance, color, moisture content, lightness, flavor, and texture.
- All exhibits are to be labeled with the two-sided tag with all information completed with a descriptive name of the products.
- All exhibits are to have recipes attached when dropped off for judging. Recipes will be kept by the Creative Talent Superintendent.
- Remove baked products from baking pans and place on disposable plates, or on covered cardboard, cut to fit the size of the product. Entries will only be accepted on disposable ware. No glass will be accepted.
- Cover all products in plastic wrap or a clear plastic bag. Bakery boxes are acceptable.
- Loaves of bread must be whole and uncut. Cookies, muffins, cupcakes, biscuits, and rolls must be the same shape and have the same recipe.
- Commercial mixes will be accepted if they are used ONLY as a base ingredient.
- Decorated Cookies can be no larger than 12" in diameter-any batter or dough can be used.
- Decorated items will not be tasted.
