



2025 Kaufman County Fair and Livestock Show Sheep / Goat Fitting Contest

RULES

- All Divisions will start at the same time and have 45 minutes to complete their requirements
- Below is a list of the requirements, based on the age of the Exhibitor. If they want to do more, they are allowed to do so.
- Due to time restraints, it is recommended that each competitor brings enough equipment, so you don't have to share.
- Goat / Sheep for the competition cannot have been clipped 2 weeks prior to the contest
- Teams will consist of 1-2 individuals. Entries in this contest are limited to Exhibitors who have valid entries (of any species) in the 2025 Kaufman County Fair and Livestock Show.
- No assistance or coaching will be allowed, once the contest begins.

AWARDS

- Awards will be given as follows for both Age Division
 - Champion Team
 - Reserve Champion Team

DIVISIONS and REQUIREMENTS

- Junior Division: 3rd – 8th Grade
 - Goat / Sheep may be washed and blowen dry prior to the start of the Competition
 - Exhibitors will be expected to clip the body of the sheep and the neck, but NOT the head
 - Exhibitors will be expected to blend the leg shag
- Senior Division: 9th – 12th Grade
 - Goat / Sheep may be washed and blowen dry prior to the start of the Competition
 - Exhibitors will be expected to clip the entire sheep
 - Exhibitors will be expected to blend the leg shag
- Set Up:
 - 30 Minutes prior to the contest, teams may set up their trimming stands and supplies in their designated area. These items should be in place at least 15 minutes prior to the announced

starting time of the contest. Each team is responsible for providing the animal and all materials.

SCORING

- Teams will be judged on the following criteria:
 - Neatness of work
 - Quality of workmanship
 - Team skills – Compatibility & Organization
 - Presentation
 - One member will present the completed animal at the end of the allotted time
